**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 21-3: PROCEDURES FOR THE FILING,  
SERVICE, AND MANAGEMENT OF HIGHLY SENSITIVE DOCUMENTS**

This court adopts General Order No. 21-4 of the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Wisconsin, except to the extent that order's terms are specific to the District Court, to govern the filing, service, and management of highly sensitive documents, as there described, as long as that order remains in effect. 
